

KYLE PETTY CHARITY RIDE ACROSS AMERICA

BY THE NUMBERS

- Since the Ride's inception in 1995, **9,350** riders have logged more than **13.1** million cumulative motorcycle miles.
- The Ride has raised more than \$22 million for Victory Junction and other charities that support chronically ill children.
- This year, riders will travel **1,400** miles, starting in Traverse City, Michigan, and ending in Hot Springs, Virginia, in seven days.
- Over the years, the Ride has visited **48** of the 50 states.
- For the 29th Anniversary, more than **225** riders will join Kyle Petty on a scenic motorcycle route traveling across **7** states, from Michigan to Virginia.
- Riders will make approximately **two to four** "pit stops" per day for fuel and fan events.
- The 28th Anniversary Ride raised \$1.8 million thanks to the generosity of riders, corporations, sponsors and individuals.
- It takes more than **\$2,500** for a child to attend Victory Junction for a week. But, through the generous support of corporations, organizations and individuals, each camper participates for free.
- Victory Junction has provided more than 136,000 camp experiences to campers and their families –
 through onsite camp programs, virtual online programming, Vic's Riders equine therapy program, and at
 participating hospitals and medical facilities through its REACH program.
